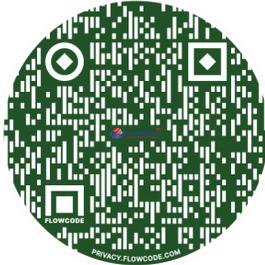

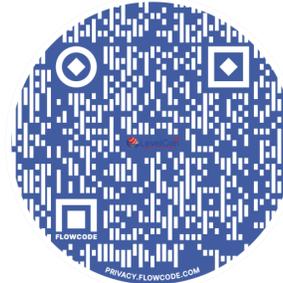


Download The LevelCon Smartphone App:

To download the LevelCon app, search for it in the Google play store or itunes, or use your smartphone camera or QR code reader to download from these links.

StarPin Basic Installation:

What's in the box: The LevelCon StarPin comes standard with pre-installed neodymium magnetic base, zip ties, and purchased sensor .

- Measure the tank's dimensions in length/height and diameter as well as the current dial reading and record the data for later use.
- Locate the Rochester dial gauge on the top of the tank. Sometimes this is located under the dome hood.
- Remove the existing dial gauge by removing the two phillips screws retaining the dial to the tank. (*image 1.1*)
- Replace the existing dial with the supplied R3D dial and connected Hall Effects sensor using the supplied phillips screws (*images 1.2, 1.3*). The replacement dial will read the same or nearly the same as the original dial.
- Place the monitor on the top curve of the tank so it is facing the sun, but not completely flat on the top of the tank. (*Images 1.4, 1.5*)
- Coil up the remaining sensor cable and zip tie it to the tank for a clean installation.
- Using the LevelCon app, force a reading from the monitor to ensure the dial reading and the reported levels are correct.

Forcing the First Report:

All units are shipped in live mode. There are two methods to wake the unit to force the essential first initial report so it begins normal reporting.

Method 1: The best method for forcing a report is to use the BLE LevelCon app. Once the app is installed from the Google Play store or iTunes, open the app and log into the account you have been given. Click the three horizontal lines at the top left of the app, scroll down and click on Wireless connect. Locate and click on the unit number on the connected device screen. Once connected, click on the log tab at the top of the screen, then click on the green circle in the lower left. Click on Report. The unit will wake up and you can see the unit report sequence on your phone.

Method 2: The solar Panel is also a light sensors. Simply cover the solar panel with your hand to block all exposed light. Hold your hand for a count of 5 seconds and then release. You will see that the blinking LED located on top of the monitor will move from a steady slow blink to a faster blink. This indicates that the unit is attempting a report. This process should be completed in decent light coverage, even overcast is ok. This process will not work in dark settings.



Accessing The Tank Data:

Once the monitor is installed and the first report has been initiated, the tank level data is automatically available on the LevelCon Web cloud portal.

To access this portal using any network connected device, navigate to <https://one.levelcon.com> to login.

- Your Username is always associated to your email address.
- The Password will be supplied by your LevelCon account manager.
- The log in will take you directly to the level dashboard.
- Click on the three vertical dotted lines next to the asset name to bring up your historical tank data.
